

# **Principals Report:**

As part of our ongoing commitment and support of Child Safe in schools we will share snippets from policies on an ongoing basis. These policies are on our webpage. As 'volunteers' Child Safe must become the norm.

#### This week's snippet:

**NOTE:** A Working with Children Check is a minimum requirement of a school's Duty of Care – it provides evidence that a person has not been found guilty of sexual abuse. It does not endorse any person as being suitable to work with children. Systematic and rigorous screening processes also need to be undertaken in every school to reduce as much as possible the risk of harm to any student.

Priests in our dioceses attended a retreat this week. We keep all priests in our prayers. They play an important part in many lives. They offer support before, during and after death. They marry us, offer guidance and support, celebrate sacraments and care for others in so many ways. Many of us think of retirement around a certain age. We all say 70 isn't old, and it isn't, but not many of us are still working full time at 70. Many priests and religious are still ministering to others on a full-time basis at the age of 70. Their calling to the vocation of priesthood (religious life) is truly sacred.




