Cyber Safety—Being Online

We all know that boys and girls see the online environment as an important means of communicating and keeping in contact with their friends. BUT, when you have just spent 5 days with your friends at school, do you need to be in contact constantly over the weekend?

Taking a selfie is fun, and you (young boys/girls) live in a different world to when your parents were growing up. Whatever we post gives everyone permission to comment, whether positive or negative. How we can make a difference, is by commenting positively or not at all.

ADVICE (edited version from p.54 of the above resource from Supre)

- Selfies can be copied and shared by others. Others can alter a selfie to make it look bad or to make it send a different message to damage a person's reputation.
- Keep selfies private via your settings.
- Every picture sends a message. Think about what the picture says about YOU.
- Who is the picture intended for. You may have a few people in mind, but others will eventually see it.
- Don't give private information about where you live or, where you are at the time. (Refer to the Snapchat example last week). Some smartphone may include Geotagging which means that your exact location is made public.

If you make a mistake talk with your parents/ carers and have the courage to talk to your friends face-to-face and say sorry.

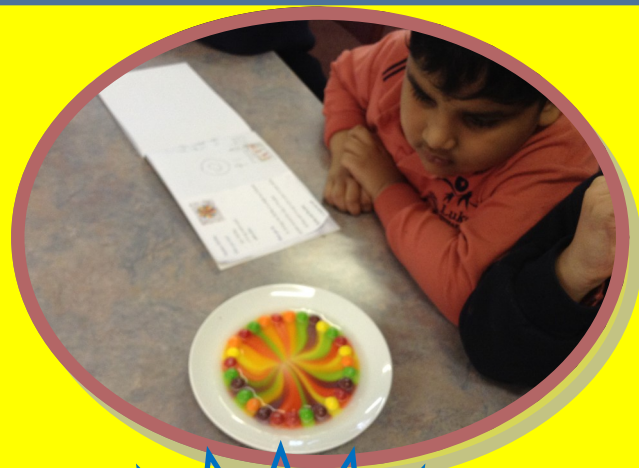
