This year they will be performing "Aladdin" which will be full of the same wonderful theatrical music, singing and dancing which we have come to know and love from the Alpha Shows in the past.

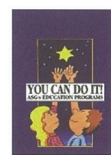

## CURRICULUM UPDATE:

### Children's Chatter Matters!

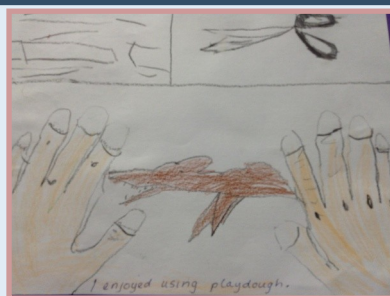
Ten activities will be provided each term focusing on key areas of oral language supporting literacy. Feel free to adjust these activities according to your child's grade level. Ten activities will be provided over this term targeting phonological awareness skills. Phonological awareness is one of the key building blocks for reading and writing. It is listening to, and thinking about the sounds in words.



**8.** After reading with your child, get him/her to describe something from the book using the 5 senses to guide à what it... *looks like / feels like / smells like / tastes like / sounds like*. You may need to prompt your child with questions and brainstorm different words together.

E.g. Birthday Cake: Looks – round and can be different colours, though is usually brown. Feels – spongy, soft, and moist. Smells – so good it makes your mouth water. Tastes – sweet and yummy.

## Community Houses Activities Day.

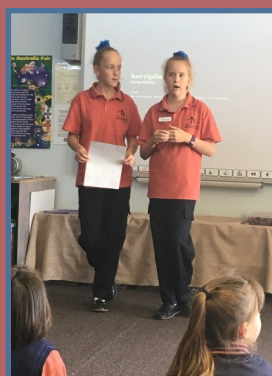

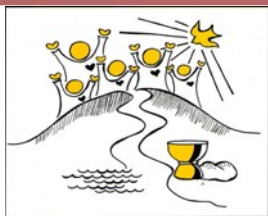

### ST PATRICK'S CATHEDRAL Organ Recital

Christopher Cook grew up in Townsville and graduated from the Queensland Conservatorium of Music in piano & organ in 1983. Continued professional development has seen him participate actively within summer courses in Italy, Sweden, Liechtenstein, France and Canada in 1985, 1997, 2000 & 2011.

Christopher has taught piano and organ at all levels since graduating from Qld Conservatorium with a Bachelor of Music Degree [in these instruments]. He enjoys a wide teaching and performance spectrum on keyboard instruments, and is involved in a voluntary director capacity introducing musicians to the wealth of expression available through the pipe organ. Christopher has worked as a soloist and continuo player with Badinerie Players, Nigel Kennedy, both Queensland Orchestras, Orchestra Victoria, as well as sensitively accompanying many musicians at all stages of development.

Christopher had held positions at major churches, schools and theological colleges demonstrating an innovative and progressive approach to music programs as Director of Music at All Saint's, Wickham Terrace, Brisbane; St Peter's, Eastern Hill, Melbourne, and St John's, Toorak.

In addition to free-lance activities as a recitalist and accompanist, Christopher is currently a répétiteur at Haileybury; a piano tutor for The Peninsula School; an organ tutor for the Faculty of Music, University of Melbourne; and Director of Music at St John's, Toorak. He is a Director of the Organ Historical Trust of Australia, and a founding Director of the Australian and New Zealand College of Organists, established to promote the pipe organ and its learning.
