

Curriculum Update:

Children's Chatter Matters!

Ten activities will be provided each term focusing on key areas of oral language supporting literacy. Feel free to adjust these activities according to your child's grade level. Ten activities will be provided over this term targeting phonological awareness skills. Phonological awareness is one of the key building blocks for reading and writing. It is listening to, and thinking about the sounds in words.



4. For every simple question you ask your child, ask two *complex* ones. You can even do this while watching television or when they're playing computer games.





For example;

Simple question: What game are you playing? (This only requires a one word answer)

Complex questions: Tell me how can get to the next level? What do would you do if that happened to you?, Why did you make that move?

Remember: "Just because" is not an acceptable answer.



. The Cooperative Parenting Program is designed to assist parents to separate relationship conflict from their ongoing parental responsibilities and to assist separated parents become more child focused and aware of the effects of their conflict on their children.

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- The Program support parents in implementing a more co-operative approach towards parenting arrangements.
- . Having a child focused philosophy the program strongly advocates the need and benefits to children of having both parents actively involved and interested in their children's life, providing this is a safe option and in the child's best interests.
- Offering a one-off, 3 hour education seminar with follow-up support also provided.
- . This Program is recognised by the Family Law Court.

* The term 'parent' is interchangeable with significant person in the child's life. It may include grandparents, relatives or other people important to the child.

How to apply for this program

- . Family members, lawyers or Community Agency Workers can telephone the Cooperative Parenting Program direct for information
- . Once an application is received from the parent, they will be invited to an interview to discuss their application.
- . If the criteria to utilise the Program has been met, the parent will be allocated a time to attend the seminar


