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

#### Children's Chatter Matters!

Ten activities will be provided each term focusing on key areas of oral language supporting literacy. Feel free to adjust these activities according to your child's

grade level. Ten activities will be provided over this term targeting phonological awareness skills. Phonological awareness is one of the key building blocks for reading and writing. It is listening to, and thinking about the sounds in words.

11. On long car trips you might like to build a story, where each person adds a new part in turn. Make sure you include the following important parts;

A setting: 'who' the story is about, 'where' the story is taking place and 'when' the story is taking place,
A problem which arises in the story or a kick off event

Feelings: how the character feels about the problem, A plan, action and solution to the problem, And an ending.

You can make it as humorous or as far- fetched as you like, most importantly it has to be fun!
