












Lunch order day is Wednesday, please remind your child to place their lunch order in the lunch tub first thing in the morning.

Simple question: What game are you playing? (This only requires a one word answer)


Complex questions: Tell me how can get to the next level? What do would you do if that happened to you?, Why did you make that move?

# **Cyber Safety**

**SNAPCHAT**- The latest update of SnapChat now tracks your child's location, and marks their location on a map for other users to see. If I didn't' have mine on ghost mode, you would be able to see my exact location of where I am while writing this post. If I was at home, you would be able to see not only my specific position marked on my street, but an exact aerial PHOTO of my house. To turn off this function, go into yours / your child's SnapChat account, and follow the instructions below:

- 1. Open the app and immediately scroll down.
- 2. Click on the settings button (the gear icon) in the top right hand corner.
- 3. Scroll down and under the 'Who can..' section, click on 'See my location'
- 4. Turn on 'Ghost Mode'



This is absolutely imperative to do on your account and especially your child's account as soon as possible. Please implement these changes immediately and spread the word to other parents to warn them about this danger.

### **Snapchat tips**

Only me (ghost mode): App defaults to this after the update and your location won't be visible on the map.

My friends: Your friends will see your location on the map Select friends: Only friends you choose will see your location on the map and friends you select won't be notified you've selected them.

To edit settings: Tap on the cog wheel in the top right corner of the map screen

Report a snap: Go to the snap you want to report > press and hold the snap > tap the square button in the bottom left corner
