COACH'S CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Abide by the rules and conditions as set down by the SPSFA and Club Administrators. Instruction Rules Booklet is available from your Club Secretary.
2. Consumption of alcohol in any form is strictly prohibited at all SPSFA scheduled matches. Failure to comply can result in fines, disqualification of individuals, teams or clubs from the SPSFA or the AFL.
3. Endeavor to attain a coaching accreditation. Courses arranged by the SPSFA or the AFL.
4. Be reasonable in your demands on the young player's time, energy and enthusiasm. Remember they have other interests.
5. Teach your players, the rules of the game are mutual agreements which none should evade or break.
6. Group players according to age, height, skill and physical maturity whenever possible.
7. Avoid over playing talented players. The "just average" players deserve equal time, if not more.
8. Remember the player's involved, play for fun and enjoyment and that winning is part of it. Never ridicule or yell at players for mistakes or losing the game.
9. Insure the equipment and facilities meet safety standards and are appropriate to the age and ability of players.
10. The scheduling and the length of practice times and competition should take into consideration the maturity of the players.
11. Develop team respect for the ability of opponents, as well as the judgment of officials and the opposing coaches.
12. Follow the advice of a physician when determining when an injured player is ready to play again.
13. Remember that your players need a coach that they can respect. Be generous with your praise when it is deserved and set a good example.
14. When addressing the team, get your message across in a constructive manner, rather than play on emotions. Never swear at the boys as some players may use the same word on the field and be disqualified for his actions that were instigated in the dressing rooms.
15. Make a personal commitment to keep yourself informed on sound coaching principle and the principles of growth and development.
16. Avoid verbal confrontation with the Club's Officials and umpires at all times. Use correct procedures to report any unfair situation that you may believe arises.

PARENT'S CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Do not force an unwilling child to participate in sports.
2. Remember, children are involved in organised sports for their enjoyment, not yours.
3. Encourage your child to always play by the rules.
4. Teach your child that an honest effort is as important as victory, so that the result of each game is accepted without undue disappointment.
5. Turn defeat to victory by helping your child work towards skill improvement and good sportsmanship. Never ridicule or yell at your child for making a mistake or losing a game.
6. Remember that children learn best by example. Applaud good plays by your team and members of the opposing team.
7. Do not question the official's judgments and never their honesty.
8. Support all efforts to remove all verbal and physical abuse from children's sporting activities.
9. Recognise the value and importance of volunteer coaches. They give up their time and resources to provide recreation activities for your child.
10. Sledging or harassment of opposition players, coaches or umpires may result in penalties for both offending parent and their player.

PLAYER'S CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Always remember that playing sport is foremost for fun and fitness
2. Your coach and any parent helpers are to be respected at all times, disobedience and disruption will not be tolerated.
3. Good sportsmanship is expected. No player will conduct themselves in any manner that will reflect poorly on The Saints Football Club.
4. The umpire's decision is final, no player is to directly question the ruling of either a field or goal umpire.
5. Offensive language and bad behaviour on or off the playing field is not acceptable.
6. Bullying will not be tolerated.
7. The Saints Football Club is fully supported by all schools involved; each school has offered additional disciplinary action in the event of inappropriate behaviour.
8. Failure to adhere to any of the above will result in penalties to players, as deemed appropriate by their coach and/or the applicable school.
